


Q3 Are you currently employed as a Registered Nurse?


Q4 Work status:











Q9 Are you currently enrolled in a BSN program or other higher degree nursing program?





Q10 If you are NOT currently enrolled in BSN program or other higher degree program, are you planning to enroll?




