



# Q11 How confident do you feel in your ability to evaluate the credibility of sources you find online?




#### Q12 How frequently do you use the LAVC Library (online or in-person)?











## Q17 How would you rate the difficulty of this class relative to other classes you've taken?



#### Q18 What was the most difficult part of this class? (Mark all that apply)






#### Q20 Why did you think about dropping the class?





#### Q23 How helpful did you find the following in this class?






## Q25 How helpful were the assigned readings (e.g. textbook, articles) for this class?


# Q26 On average how many hours a week did you spend outside of class time (e.g. reading, studying)?




### Q28 What grade do you think you will get in this class?


