WHAT IS UPWARD BOUND?

Upward Bound provides fundamental support to participants in their preparation for college entrance. The program provides opportunities for participants to succeed in their precollege performance and ultimately in their higher education pursuits. Upward Bound serves: high school students from low-income families and from families in which neither parent holds a bachelor's degree. The goal of Upward Bound is to increase the rate at which participants complete secondary education and enroll in and graduate from institutions of postsecondary education.

Upward Bound provides academic instruction in mathematics, laboratory sciences, composition, literature, and foreign languages. Tutoring, counseling, mentoring, cultural enrichment, work-study programs, education or counseling services designed to improve the financial and economic literacy of students. We serve students from groups that are traditionally underrepresented.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students in the 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th grades who attend a UB target high schools are eligible to apply. The target schools are Fulton College Preparatory, Grant HS and Van Nuys HS.

Applicants must also meet the guidelines established by the U.S. Department of Education; the guidelines state that participants be potential first generation college students who come from low-income family backgrounds. Applicants must also demonstrate a need for the program services. Those applicants selected for the UB Program maintain their eligibility in the program until graduation from high school, regardless of any change in the family status. The participant must posses a valid social security number and be a Citizen of the United States or a United State Resident.

WHAT DOES LAVC UB OFFER?

The LAVC Upward Bound offers a comprehensive program of educational support services, college advising and career exploration.

THE ACADEMIC YEAR

From September through May, students attend weekly and monthly seminars as well as field trips. Individual and group tutorial sessions are offered from 3:30pm to 6:00pm during the week.

THE UPWARD BOUND SUMMER PROGRAM EXPERIENCE

Upward Bound students participate in a 6-week program. Students attend courses designed to strengthen their life skills and intellectual abilities. Students who successfully complete these courses may receive high school credits applicable to their graduation requirements and/or transferable general education college units.

ACADEMIC & COLLEGE ADMISSION ADVISING

In addition to the instructional support services, UB provides academic guidance and college admission advising. Students receive assistance completing college applications, financial aid and scholarship forms.

COLLEGE/CAREER AWARENESS

To further enrich each student's profile, UB also provides various student interest workshops and activities focusing on college/career awareness.
