POST survey taken week 13 – end of term 90 responses

Comparing "strongly" + "somewhat" agreement, pre vs post "Post" survey reflective items

Highlights

Clear, definitive increases on a handful of items

Increases on broad items involving tasks / general habits

Several items about students' personal story/journey saw no or negative change in agreement, but positive change in "strong agreement"

Slight decrease in students feeling they belonged in college or at LAVC, but higher proportion agreed strongly that they did belong

Highest Increases in Agreement

Survey Item	"Strongly or Somewhat Agree"
I developed skills in College 101 that will help me be successful.	93%
College 101 was worth my time and effort.	91%
I would recommend College 101 to other students.	89%

Clear, definitive increases on a handful of items

Personal relationship with a professor (+21) Knowing "hot topics" in areas of interest for major (+12) Scaffolding assignments for myself (+11)

Increases on broad items involving tasks / general habits

I have a Comprehensive Ed Plan (+9) Knowing services offered by Counseling (+7) Knowing skills I possess, and what I need for success (+7) Implementing study strategies (+6)

Several items about students' personal story/journey saw no or negative change in agreement, but positive change in "strong agreement"

I am able to tell a meaningful and focused story of my personal educational journey. (-0.7 agreement, +13 strongly agree)

I see how my experiences, culture and community shape how I frame my personal identity. (+0.2 agreement, +7 strongly agree)

Slight decrease in students feeling they belonged in college or at LAVC, but higher proportion agreed strongly that they did belong

I feel like I belong at LAVC (-3 agreement, +9 strongly agree)

I feel like I belong in College (-4 agreement, +9 strongly agree)
