II. Fall 2024 Admission Notes for UCLA

- UCLA College Transfer Alliance Program (TAP) Scholarship Once admitted to UCLA, TAP students should receive a letter of invitation for TAP Scholarship, which will include instructions and a link to application. There is an essay and letter of recommendation, and it is due May 9, 2024.
- Official Transcripts are due July 1, 2024 with coursework through Spring 2024.
- AP and IB Test scores are due July 15, 2024.
- IGETC Certification is due September 1, 2024 (Full UC IGETC certification will be posted on your LACCD transcript by the LAVC Graduation Office if a Graduation Petition was submitted).
- Reporting Academic Changes as an Admitted UCLA Transfer Student should be done immediately if you find you will not be able to meet any provision in your Admission Contract.
- **ADMITS TO ALTERNATE MAJOR** If you were not admitted to your first-choice major, but were admitted to your alternate major, this is unlikely to change. Admissions decisions are based on space.

IV. Accepting a UC Offer of Admission

As a reminder, the transfer SIR deadline of **June 1** remains the same. Students can accept an admission offer by agreeing to the provisions/conditions outlined in the offer and submitting their Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) with the SIR deposit to reserve their space at a campus. The SIR deposit is \$250. Some important things to keep in mind about accepting a UC admission offer:

- 1) Students can accept only one admission offer from one UC campus.
- 2) The SIR deposit is applied to the student's first enrollment term tuition.
- 3) Students that qualified for the UC application fee waiver may also qualify to defer their SIR deposit until financial aid is disbursed.
- 4) The SIR deposit is nonrefundable and nontransferable.
- 5) Further documentation regarding residency status for tuition determination purposes may be required and specifics can be <u>reviewed here</u>.

V. Transfer/Scholarship Season is Here!

Many scholarship opportunities are available in spring for students transferring Fall 2023. Now is the time to ask professors for **letters of recommendation** to include with your transfer/scholarship applications. Letters of recommendation from professors most familiar with your academic abilities and potential for university-level work carry the most weight. As a secondary reference, an employer who knows your skills/talents can be a great person to ask for a letter of recommendation, especially if you are working in a field related to your educational/career goals. It is also helpful if your reference knows a few things about you. You may want to provide them with bullet points or a brief bio about yourself and your goals so they have an idea of what to include in their letter. Make sure to give professors/employers plenty of advanced notice with all the details they need, including the names of the organization/school, addresses, and particulars of each scholarship. You may find providing preaddressed, stamped envelopes makes their task easier, if something needs to be sent via U.S. mail.

To view the full list of LAVC Honors Courses offered in Fall 2024, please click Class Search at the top of LAVC's website. Be sure that Fall 2024 is the selected Term, LAVC is the Campus, and under Class Search Type, choose Honors ("12 Honors") then click Search at the bottom. Copy the 5-digit Class # of the Honors course you want to take and enter it in Add Classes field under Manage Classes tile on Student Homepage. This is the same process for Spring terms. LAVC does not offer dedicated Honors courses in Winter/Summer, but TAP students may take advantage of an Honors Contract in those terms. Please be aware that although LAVC makes every effort to offer the courses as they are initially posted, schedule adjustments or instructor switches do happen which can affect Honors classes. In addition, as only a small number of Honors seats are reserved in some classes (BIOLOGY 006 & 007, for example), there may no longer be Honors seats available when you are eligible to enroll. Thus, it is always advised to select backup options/schedules from the one in your student education plan, or the one you have mapped out.
