Impact on Budget Limitations

The college has gone through numerous fiscal limitations from 2008-2015. Inadequate budget allocations have had a direct impact on student services provided by the college. Tutoring services, library hours, computer laboratory and writing laboratory hours have not met student demand. As a result, many students have been unable to use these important services that have been shown to contribute to college success.

Impact on Campus Facilities

The college is expected to provide a clean and attractive environment that is conducive to a positive learning experience. However, because of fiscal limitations, the college has been unable to provide places where students can gather to study singly or in study groups. The campus has made it a priority to maintain a clean campus environment.

STRENGTHS

Recovery Efforts

The college was placed on WARNING status in 2012, and was provided with 8 recommendations for improvement. The WARNING has been removed, and the college is now fully accredited. The college budget has been increased and it is now more likely to become sustainable.

Campus Food Services

The college is undergoing a major transformation. During the construction enabled by the bond program, the old cafeteria building was demolished and a new Student Union Building is now under construction. The new building will include a top of the line cafeteria. In the meantime, the college has limited options for students (and staff) to eat. Presently, our students are using campus vending machines and the services of a food truck to temporarily meet this need.
