



Program Expectations:

TRIO/SSS is a U.S. Department of Education program that provides services to students who are first generation college students, and/or low-income and/or have a physical or learning disability. In addition, a student must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident. Our program provides services that promote retention and transfer.

We will provide a comprehensive array of services including tutoring; mentoring; one-on-one academic and career counseling; transfer, financial aid and study skills workshops; field trips to universities, museums, etc.; a computer lab; and a laptop loan program.

Of the 16,000+ students attending LAVC, only 160 students will be selected for this program and they will be chosen according to their academic need as well as their commitment to participate in the program.

Students eligible for Pell grants with unmet needs or loan requirements may be able to receive additional grants funds.

To become a member of SSS, you must meet with the TRIO/SSS counselor for appointment during which she will discuss the components of the program, assess your academic needs and determine your eligibility.
