- 3. I am a current foster youth in California's child welfare system, or a former foster youth in California due to emancipation or aging out of the system.**
Provide: (a) a copy of a juvenile dependency court document indicating foster care in California's child welfare system; or (b) documentation from county social services confirming you were under the care of the Department of Social Services.
- 4. I have lived with an adult California resident (other than my parent) who has provided direct care and control over me for the past two years.**
Provide documentation of: (a) the adult's immigration status and California residence for the past year, and (b) your living with this adult for not less than two years.
- 5. I have supported myself financially for at least the past year.**
Provide documentation of: (a) your employment (e.g., W-2); (b) your presence in California the past year; and (3) your expenses the past year.

PART C – FOR STUDENTS WHO ATTENDED THIS COLLEGE IN THE PAST YEAR

Provide: (a) a copy of your DD Form 214 ("DD 214"), showing the date of your discharge from active service; or (b) a copy of a Certificate of Eligibility from the Department of Veterans Affairs ("VA").
- 2. I am a dependent of a veteran of the United States Armed Forces who is enrolling in college within three years of the veteran's discharge (or death in the line of duty) following a period of active duty of 90 days or more.**
Provide: (a) documentation that you are a dependent for an exemption for federal tax purposes; and (b) a copy of the veteran's DD 214 or Certificate of Eligibility from the VA.
- 3. I am currently a member of the United States Armed Forces stationed in California on active duty.**
Provide: (a) a statement from your commanding officer or personnel officer that your assignment to active duty in California is not for educational purposes; and (b) evidence of the date of assignment to California.
- 4. I am a child or spouse of a member of the United States Armed Forces stationed in California on active duty.**
Provide: (a) documentation that you are a dependent for federal tax purposes; and (b) a statement from the military person's commanding officer or personnel officer that the military person's duty station is in California on active duty or that the military person is outside of California on active duty after having been transferred immediately and directly from a California duty station after the residence determination date.
- 5. I graduated from a California high school, and attended (a) a California high school for at least three years, or (b) attended at least three years in California elementary schools and/or secondary schools and earned credits in California from a California high school equivalent to three or more years of full-time high school coursework.**
Complete an AB 540 Nonresident Tuition Exemption Request Form.
- 6. I am a U.S. citizen living in a foreign country who previously lived in California and whose parent/guardian was deported.**
Complete an SB 141 Nonresident Tuition Exemption Request Form.
- 7. I am a public school employee with a valid credential.**
Provide: (a) a statement from your public school employer confirming that your full-time position requires certification qualifications for the current college year; and (b) a copy of your credential.
- 8. My parent(s) or I earn a living primarily through agricultural work for hire in California.**
Provide: (a) documentation that you or your parent earn a living primarily by performing agricultural labor for hire in California and that such labor has been performed in California for at least two months in each of the prior two years; and-- if your parent earns living through agricultural work for hire-- documentation that (b) your parent lives within the District; and (c) you were claimed as a dependent for federal and state tax purposes if your parent earned sufficient income to incur a tax liability.

- 9. I am a federal civil service employee, or a dependent of such employee, who moved to California as a result of a military mission reassignment that relocated at least 100 employees.**
Provide documentation of the employment and reassignment to California, and if applicable, documentation that you are a dependent for an exemption for federal tax purposes.
- 10. I am currently a law enforcement trainee, and a public agency intends to classify me as a peace officer upon completion of coursework in the LACCD.**
Provide documentation of: (a) your passage of all other requirements of the hiring public agency; and (b) the public agency's intention to classify you as a peace officer.
- 11. I graduated from a school in California operated by the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs ("BIA").**
Provide a copy of your diploma from a BIA high school (e.g., Sherman Indian High School).
- 12. I am an amateur athlete in training at the United States Olympic Training Center in Chula Vista, California.**
Provide documentation of your status at the United States Olympic Training Center.

The burden of proof is on the student to clearly demonstrate both physical presence in California and intent to establish a permanent home in California. You must present the originals of at least two kinds of documentation from the list below.

- Federal or California state income tax forms from previous year showing a California home address
- Documentation of purchase/lease of residential real estate in California covering a one-year period
- California automobile registration
- California voter registration
- Utility bills (e.g., gas, water, power, phone) with a California address covering a one-year period
- California driver's license or California identification card
- California vehicle registration
- Active California bank account statements covering a one-year period
- Selective Service registration with a California permanent address
- Receipt of benefits from a California state agency covering a one-year period
- California occupational license
- Other documentation showing residence in California for the last year: _____
