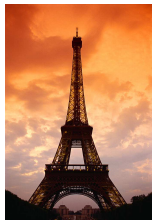
Introducing VCAP - Valley College Accelerated Program

This summer, LAVC officially launched its new and improved Los Angeles Valley College Accelerated Program (VCAP), which is pronounced “vee-cap”. This program replaces the PACE (Program for Adult College Education) program, and is designed to help students meet their employment and family obligations while earning a college degree or transfer units. It now offers three degree tracks, increases the frequency of night and evening classes for working students, and includes hybrid and online classes. “This new name for the program will identify it more closely with LAVC,” said Roana Thornock, VCAP director. “VCAP will continue to fulfill its traditional role of introducing and orienting re-entry students to college life.”



Georgia Mercer wins run-off election for LACCD Board of Trustees seat

Final results from the May 15 election have been certified, and incumbent Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) Trustee Georgia L. Mercer has won re-election with 50.09% of the votes (63,830). Challenger Roy Burns received only 49.91% (63,592 votes). Mercer has served on the Board of Trustees since 1998 and faced three challengers on the first ballot in March 2007.



LAVC student awarded grant to study in Paris for the summer

The LAVC Department of Foreign Languages announced that student Jennifer Landaverde was awarded with a full grant to study French this summer at the University of Paris (La Sorbonne) with the LAVC Summer in Paris program. The grant is funded by the H. Dennis and Anne Beaver Foundation, which pays for all expenses including travel, tuition, cultural excursions, and a homestay with a French family, and gives the student a modest weekly allowance to cover meals and incidental expenses.
