LAVC Campus Closed for Winter Break

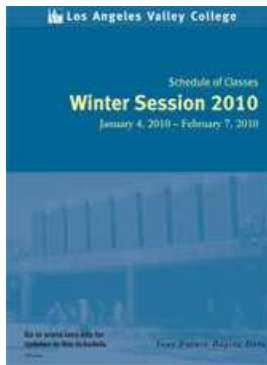
LAVC will be closed on December 24-27 and 30-31, 2009 and January 1-3, 2010 for Winter Break.

He receives federal assistance to help support his family, and he works 35-40 hours a week at a group home for high-risk and challenged youth. The Sheriff's Office presented the family with a Christmas tree with decorations, toys for their 4 kids and a Christmas dinner which will be prepared by Vons Market on Thursday, December 17 at the LAVC Sheriff's Office.
