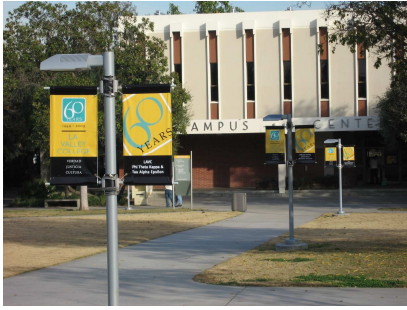
### **Calling All Students! Sign Up Today for STEM Winter Bridge 2010**
