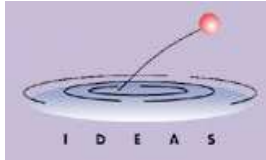
Construction Notification - Parking Lot D Temporarily Closed

Parking Lot D will be closed between January 6-February 6, 2011, March 8-June 7, 2011 and June 9-August 15, 2011 for the construction of new photovoltaic panels in the parking lot. Access to the Child Development & Family Complex will now be available off Campus Drive, and access to Maintenance & Operations / Sheriff's Station will be available off Emelita Street. Once completed this new photovoltaic panel installation, which will provide much desired shaded parking to Parking Lot D, could potentially reduce the campus's energy consumption by \$400,000 annually. Need Help Balancing Work & Your Personal Life? Use the LACCD Employee Assistance Program!

All benefited active LAVC employees, retirees, their dependents are eligible to receive free health and wellness services through the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) Employee Assistance Program (EAP). This program, which is runs through Horizon Health, provides employees with a variety of services including:

- free counseling sessions related to personal, marital, family, relationship, work, alcohol and substance abuse problems (up to 5 sessions, per issue, per year) by a licensed mental health provider;
- referrals to mental health agencies and non-medical agencies that are beyond the scope of an EAP provider;
- a 24-hour, 7-days-a-week crisis hotline;
- a half-hour consultation with an attorney (one session, per calendar year);
- a financial counseling referral for a consultation with a financial consultant (one session, per calendar year);
- telephone and Web-based referral services for work and life issues; and
- workshops on various wellness and self-improvement topics.
