Calling All Parents! Sign Your Kids Up for the LAVC Monarch Day Camp

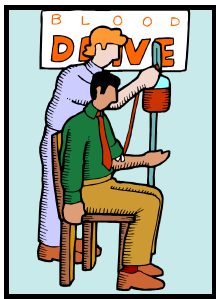

LAVC to Present the Broadway Musical Cabaret on July 23-24

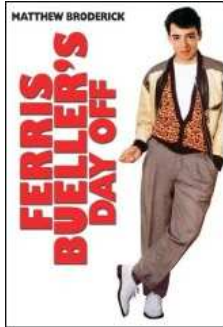
