LAVC Pool Now Open to the Community through LAVC Community Services

The Community Services Department offers private swimming lessons, adult lap swimming, family swim time, a splash club for kids, and parent and me swimming lessons in the LAVC Pool during the summer. Private 30-minute swim lessons for adults and kids (must be at least 5 years old and toilet trained) are offered Mondays-Fridays. Adult lap swimming (must be 18 years old and older) is available from Mondays-Friday from 6:30-9:30 p.m. Family Swim, which is open swim time for families (children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult; lap swimming is not allowed), is offered on Saturdays from 1:30-4:30 p.m. The Splash Club, an intermediate and advanced training in stroke movement and endurance for kids 6 and older (tryout is required), is offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4-5 p.m. The Parent & Me swim lessons (for children ages 2 - 4.5 years old who are potty trained and must wear a swim diaper) is a shared parent and child swim classes are offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays, or Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 9-9:30 a.m. The cost for the private and Parent & Me lessons vary depending on the number of lessons per week. An adult lap swimming pass is \$35 for 10 visits, \$65 for 20 visits and \$60 for 30 visits. The cost for Family Swim is \$2.50 per person, and Splash Club is \$30 per month. Library, Learning Center and Media Services have Moved

Due to the upcoming demolition of the current Library building, the Library, Learning Center and Media Services have moved to new modular building complex located to the east of the Cafeteria.

The new Temporary Library is the largest modular building in the complex, and the Learning Center is the smaller modular building (between the Temporary Library and the Business Office). Media Services (formerly known as IMS or Instructional Media Services) is located on the east side of the Learning Center bungalow. Both the Temporary Library and the Learning Center will be closed for the duration of the summer, and will reopen in the Fall. 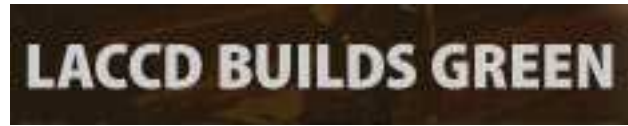
