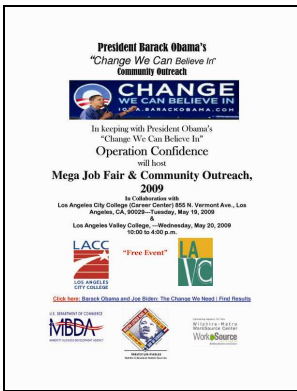
Hillel 818 Hosts a "Coffee and Conversation with Shelley Berman"
