



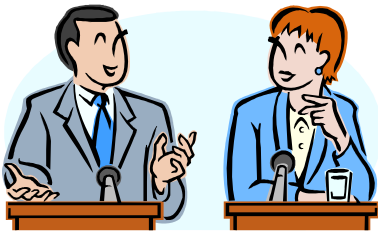

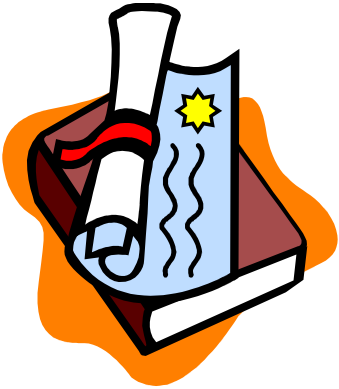
LA City Council District 2 Debate with Krekorian and Essel

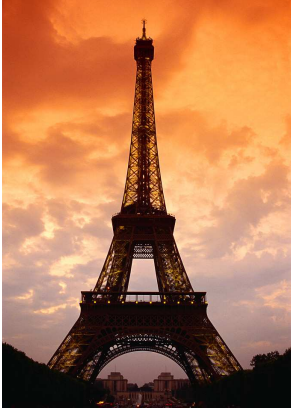
Attention Job Seekers! Join the LAVC Job Club on December 4
