- Teach a full load in assigned didactic and clinical areas; supervise and evaluate student performance
- Ability to work flexible hours
- Prepare students to work as entry-level registered nurses

- Communicate and work effectively with students, faculty, and health care personnel in affiliating agencies

Minimum District Qualifications:

- Master's degree in nursing **or**
- Bachelor's degree in nursing **and** Master's degree in health education, health science, or the equivalent
- meet the health requirements for instructors as stated by the LACCD
- demonstrate evidence of sensitivity to and understanding of culturally diverse academic, socio-economic, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students

ALSO the candidate must meet or exceed the minimum qualifications as set by the Board of Registered Nursing

- current/valid California Registered Nurse license
- at least one year of continuous, full time experience, within the previous five years as a registered nurse providing direct patient care
- demonstrate current competence in the assigned teaching area
- complete at least one year experience teaching courses related to registered nursing **or** a course which includes practice in teaching registered nursing

Other Desirable Qualifications:

- experience teaching in an accredited nursing program
- ability to work collaboratively with colleagues as a team member and effectively with community educational partners

- possess national or state certification in nursing education or area of specialty
- ability to write proposals and coordinate research grants
- evidence of professional leadership in nursing education or specialty area
