International Student Tuition and Fees

As non-residents of California, International students are required to pay a **non-refundable \$ 50** application fee, non-resident tuition and SEVIS fees. International students are not eligible for financial aid. **Fees are subject to change.**

Non-Resident Tuition: International student non-resident tuition is \$251 per unit. You are required to enroll in a minimum of 12 units each fall and spring semester.	\$ 3,012.00	\$ 6,024.00
Enrollment Fee: All students must pay an enrollment fee of \$46 per unit (\$46 x 12 units). International students are required to pay this fee in addition to the non-resident tuition. It is anticipated that the enrollment fee may increase as a result of legislative action. The increase would apply to all California Community Colleges.	\$ 552.00	\$ 1,104.00
Student Health Fee: All students at Los Angeles Valley College are required to pay an \$11 Student Health Fee per semester. The Student Health Fee allows you access to the Student Health Center where you can receive limited low-cost medical services. However, the Student Health fee is not medical insurance.	\$ 11.00	\$ 22.00
Medical Insurance: International students MUST purchase Los Angeles Valley College Medical Insurance Plan (No exceptions).	\$ 666.00	\$ 1,332.00
Student Representation Fee: Student Representation Fee is charged every semester. This fee supports student representatives involved in governmental affairs.	\$ 1.00	\$ 2.00
Associated Student Union (ASU): ASU is student government at LAVC. It is designed to give students a voice in how the college is governed.	\$ 10.00	\$ 20.00
Parking: A valid parking permit is required for all vehicles using campus parking facilities during regular school hours. (optional-not included in the total cost)	\$ 20	\$ 40.00
Books and Supplies: Textbooks and supplies cost approximately \$ 1,854 per year.	\$ 927.00	\$ 1,854.00
SEVIS Fee: The United States Federal Government requires that international students be registered in SEVIS every semester; therefore, the college has a \$25 SEVIS Maintenance Fee each semester.	\$ 25.00	\$ 50.00
*Estimated Room and Board:		\$ 17,724.00
Annual Total:		\$28,132.00

* Excluding Room and Board, the average cost per year is \$ 10,408.00; however, **proof of funds for \$28,132 is required.**

** Please note that for **each** dependent (spouse and/or child) an extra \$1,000.00 would be required per academic year.
