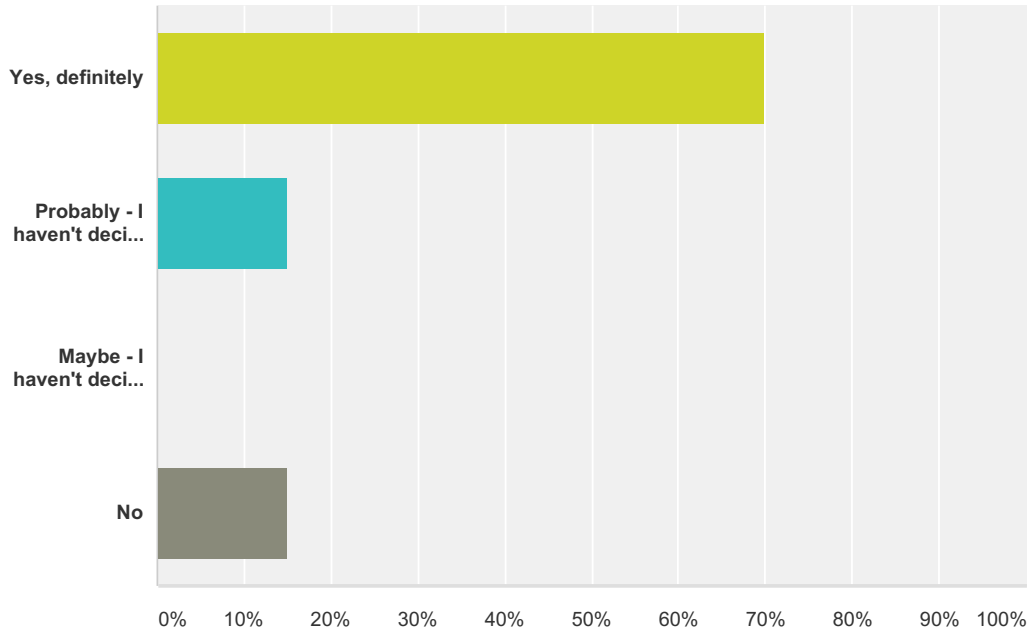


Q1 Are you majoring in Anthropology?

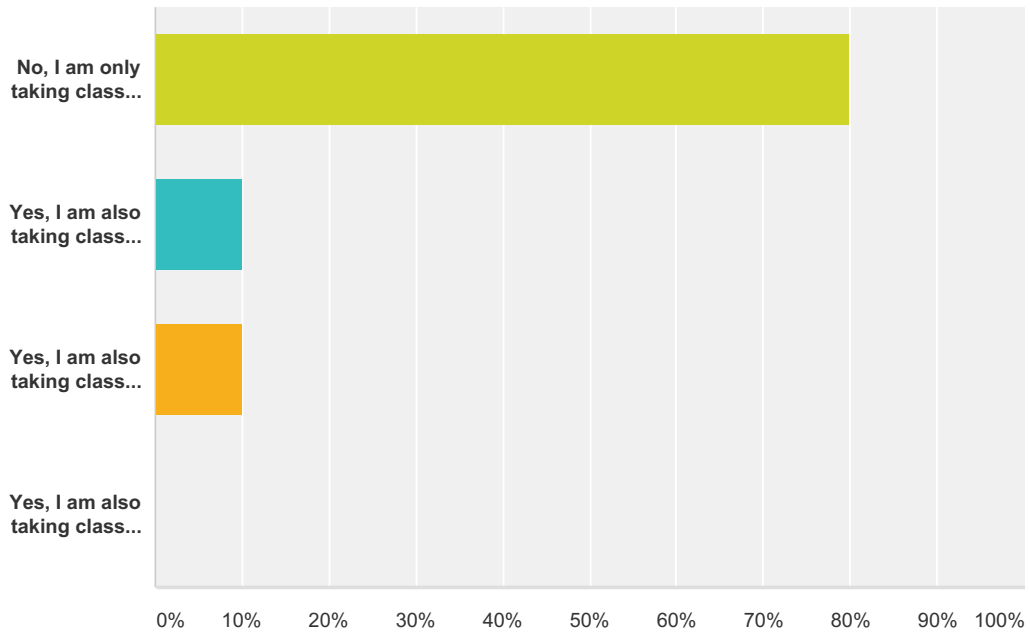

Q2 Are you also taking classes at another campus in addition to Valley College?

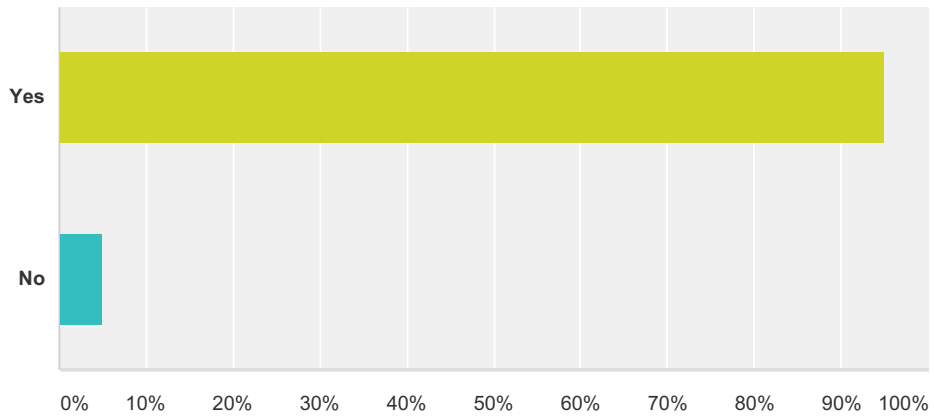

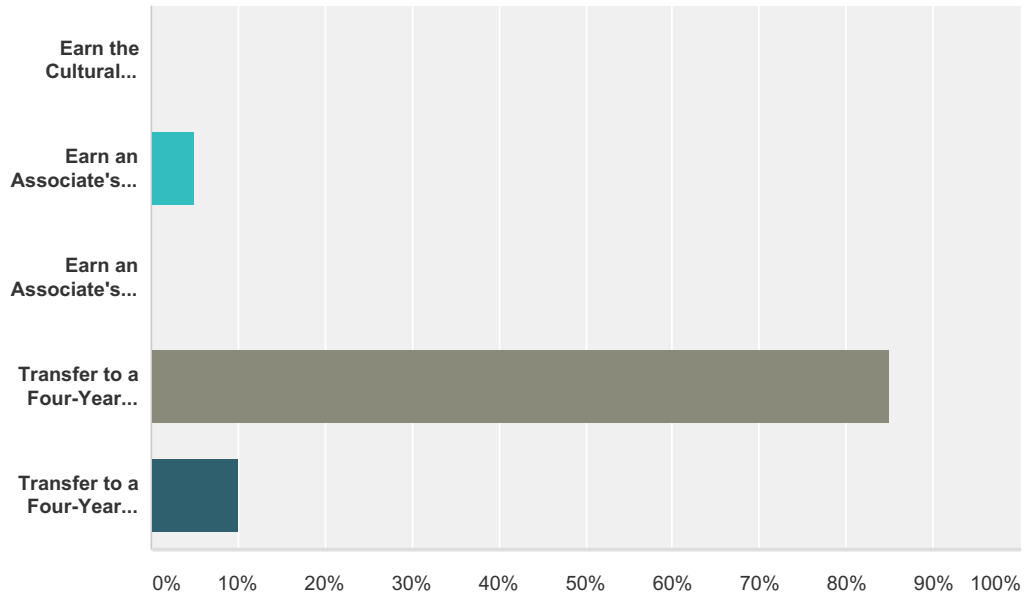

Q4 What is your educational goal?

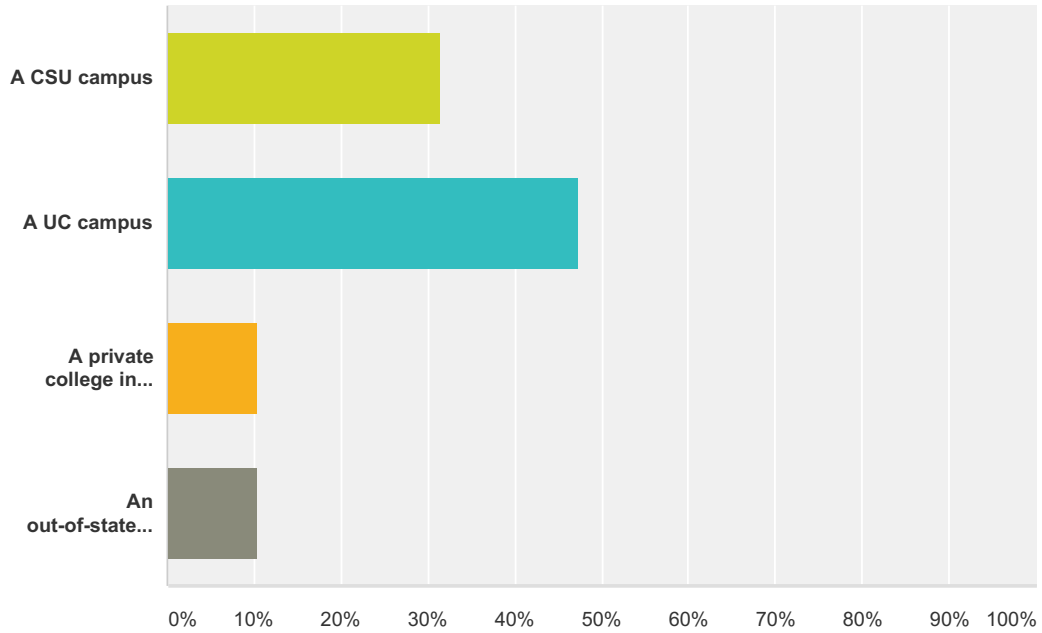

Q5 Where do you plan on transferring?

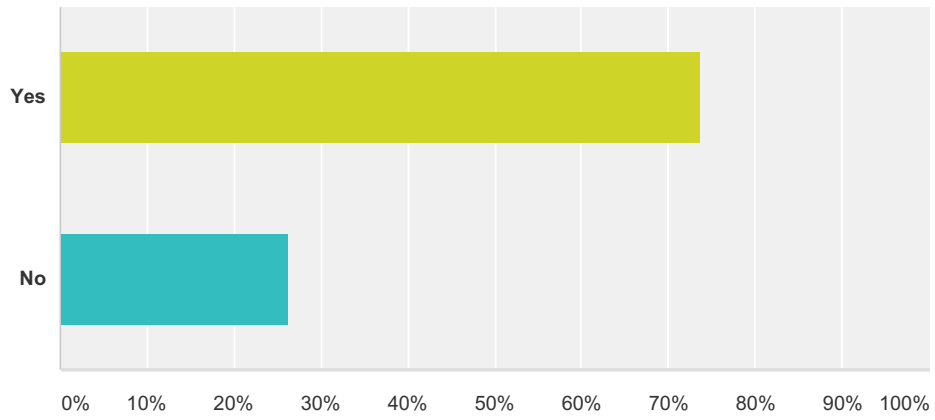

Q6 Do you plan on earning an associate's degree before transferring?

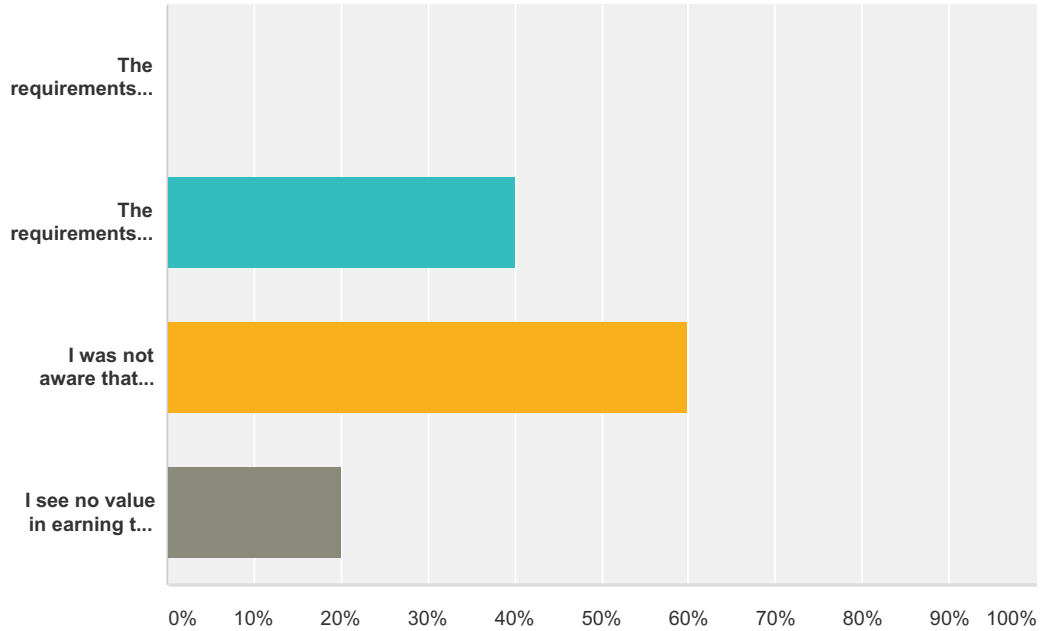

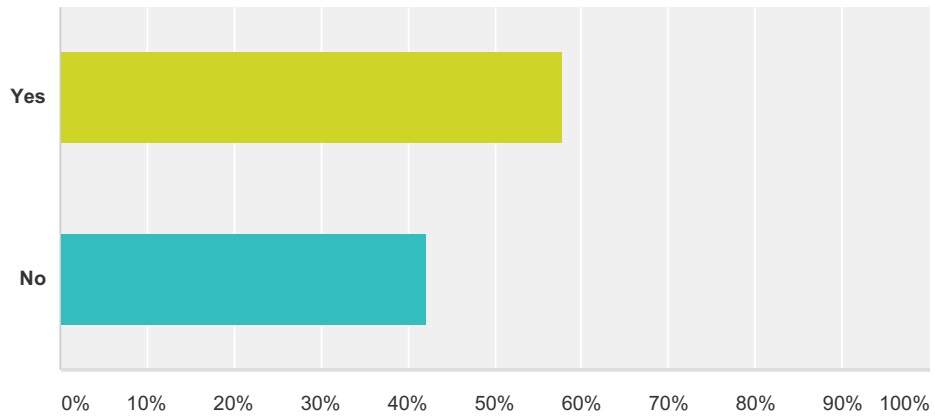

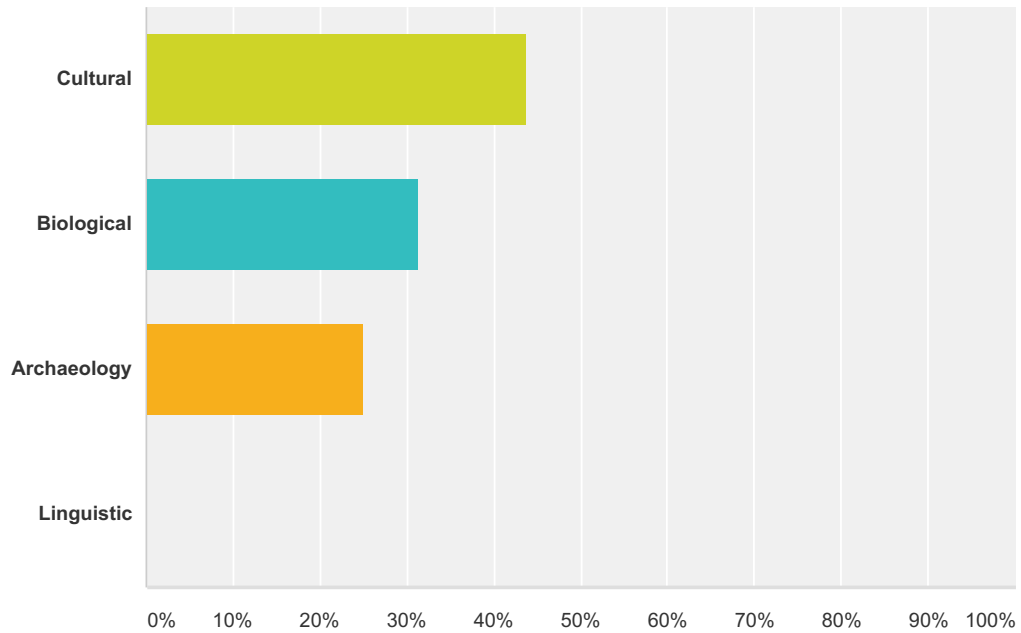

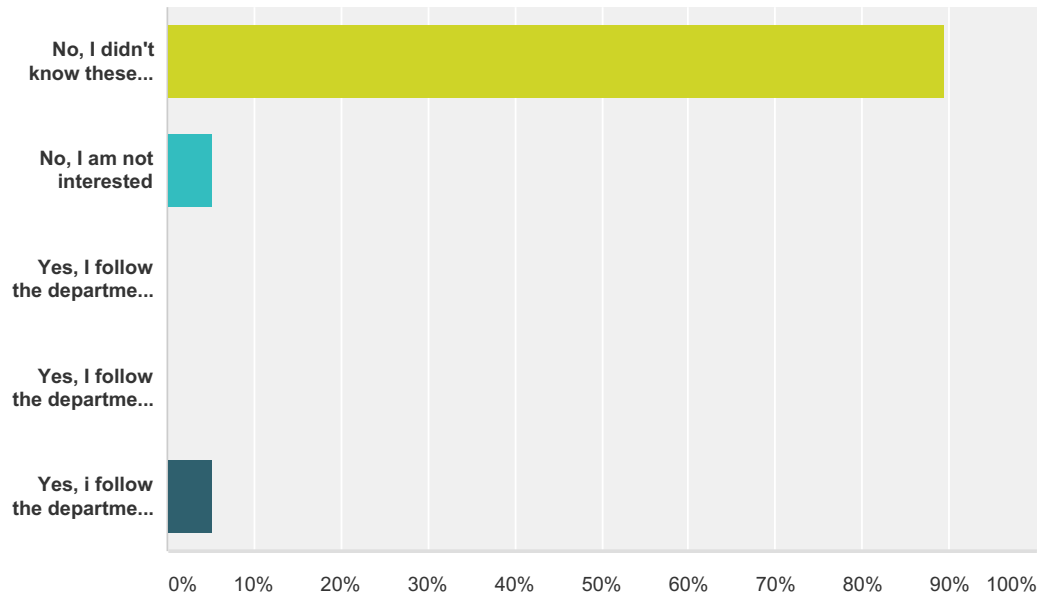

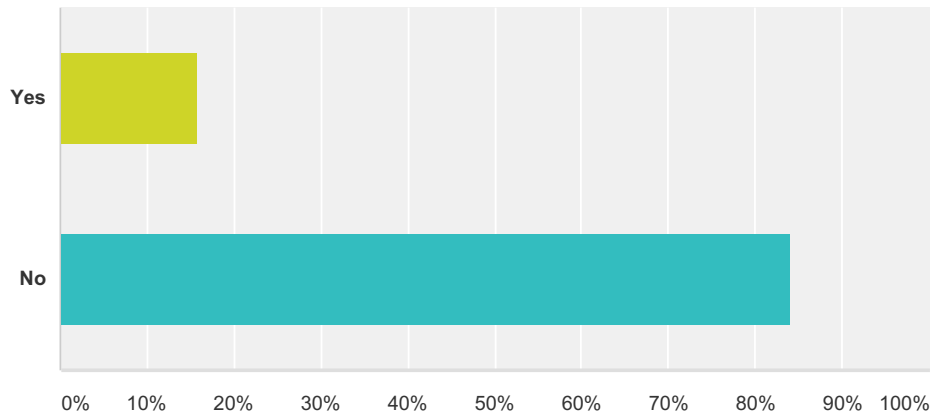
