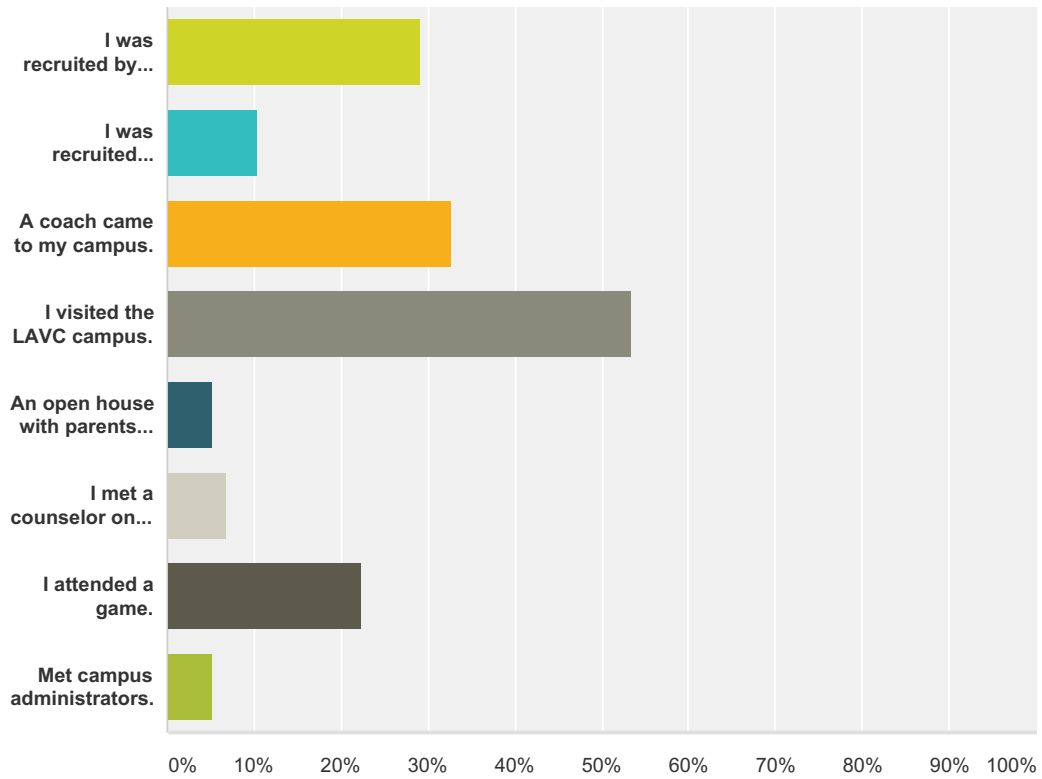

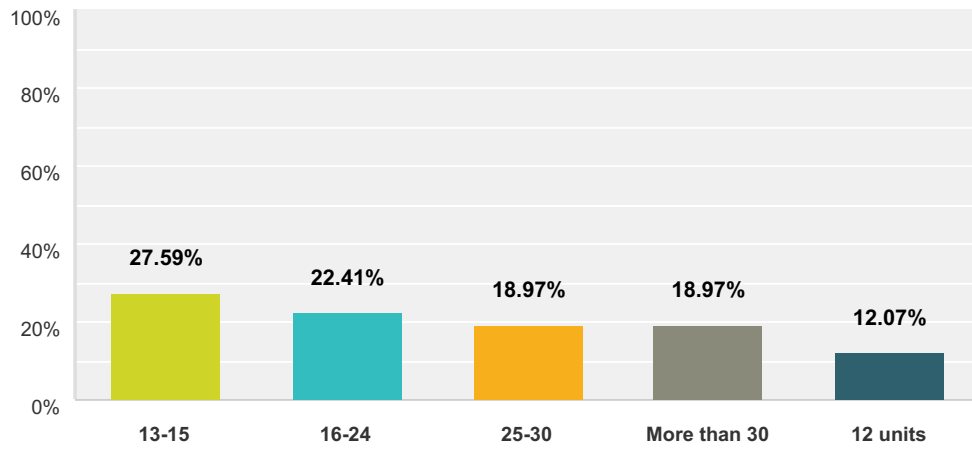

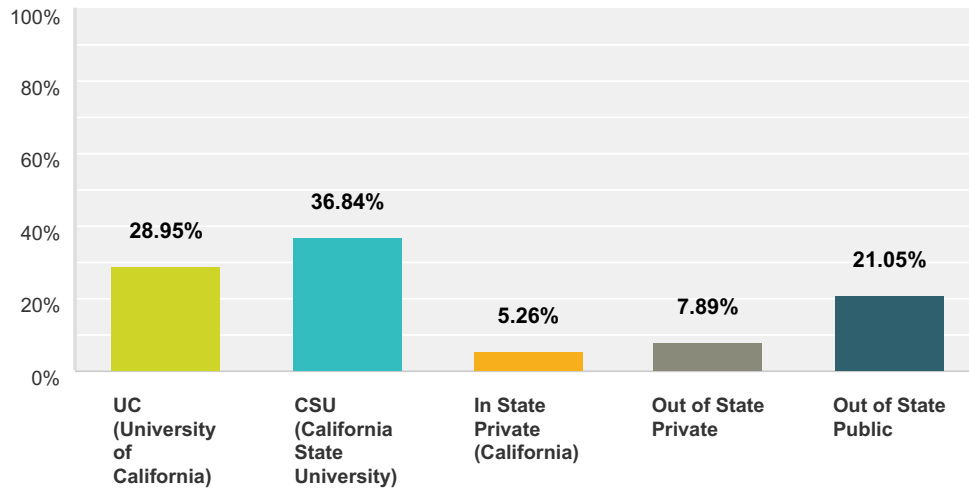

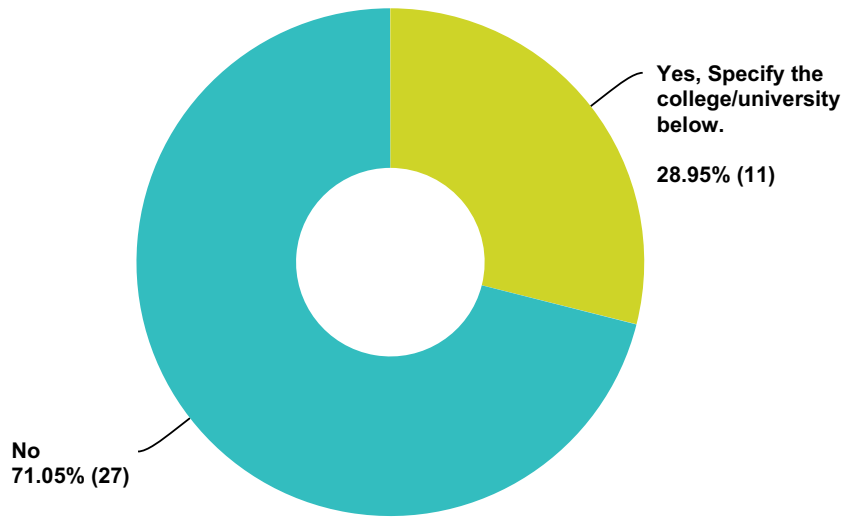

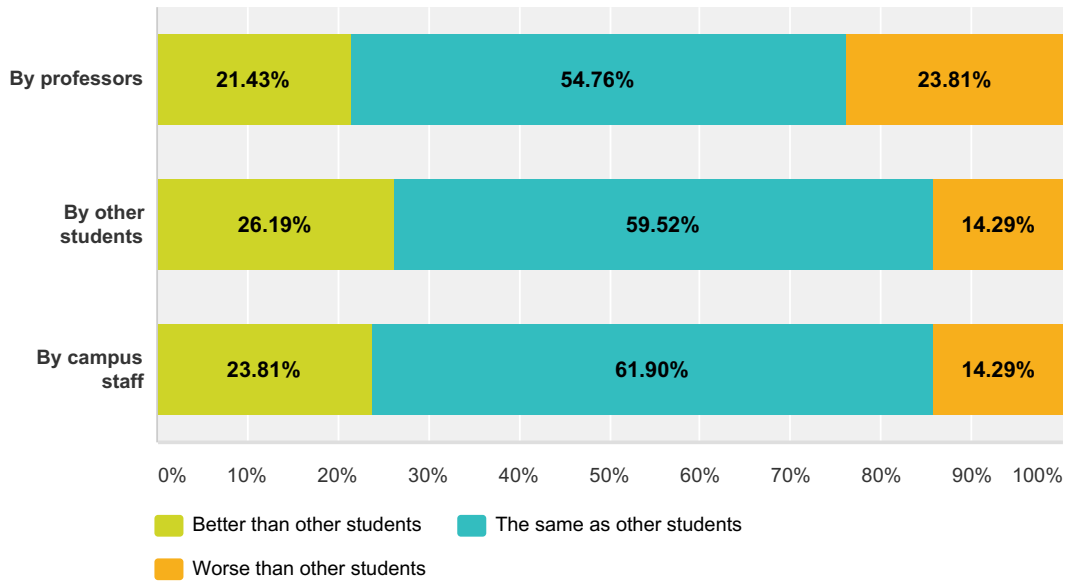

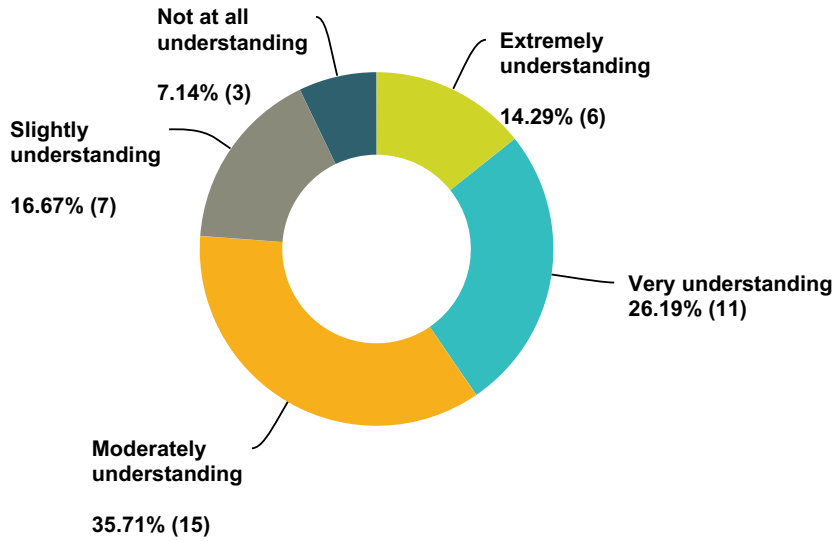

Q27 How understanding are your professors about your athletic responsibilities?

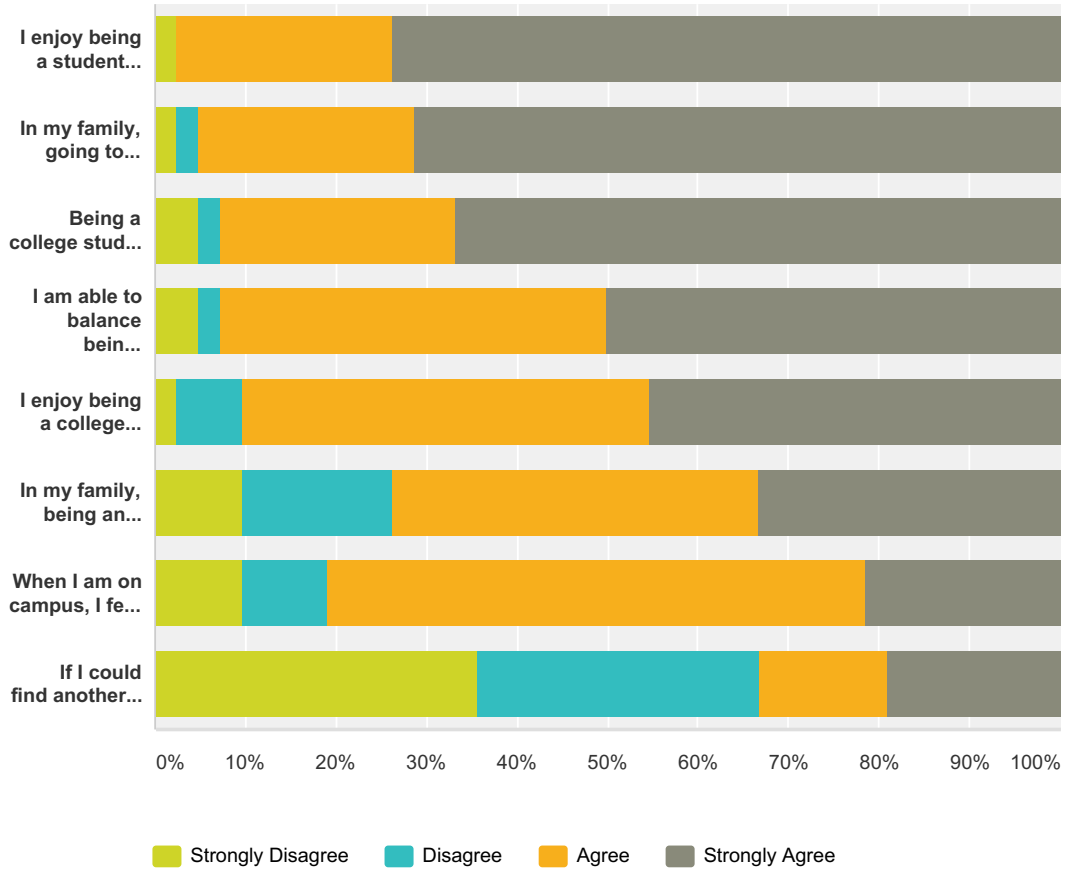

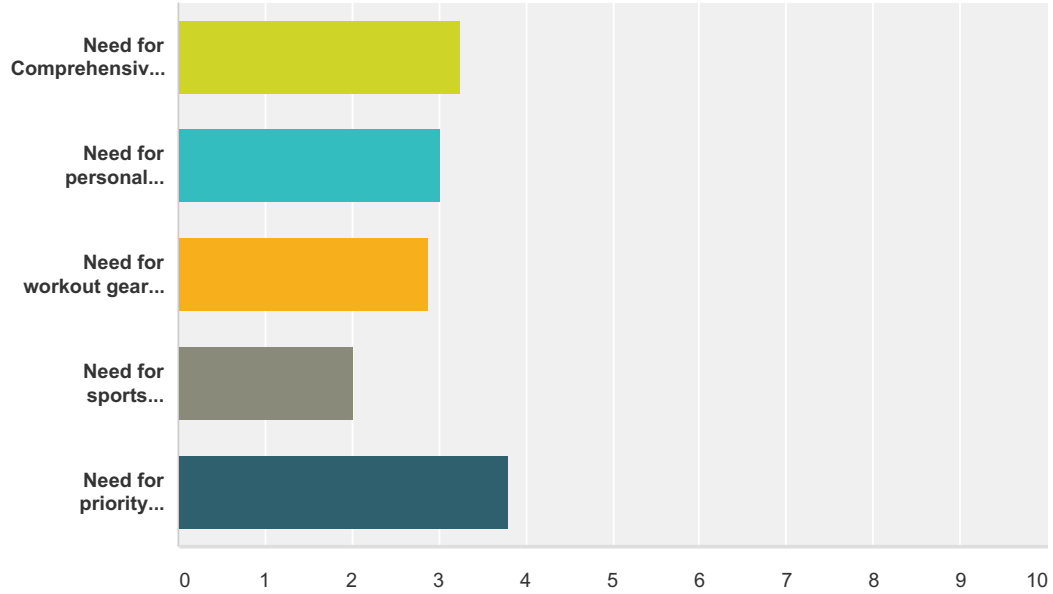
