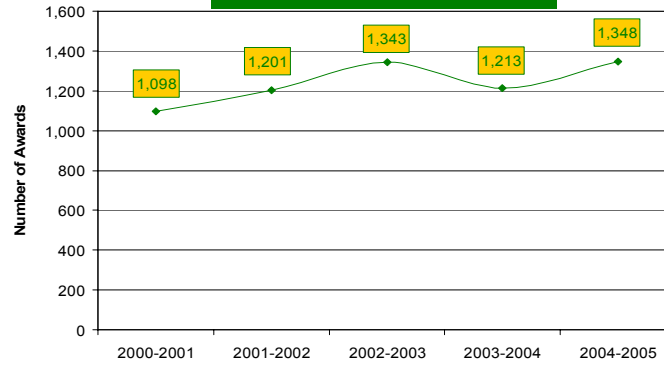

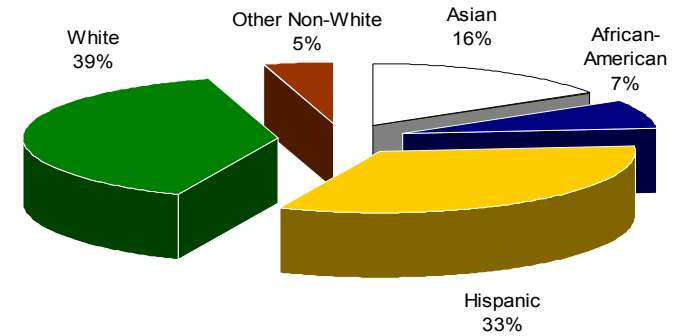

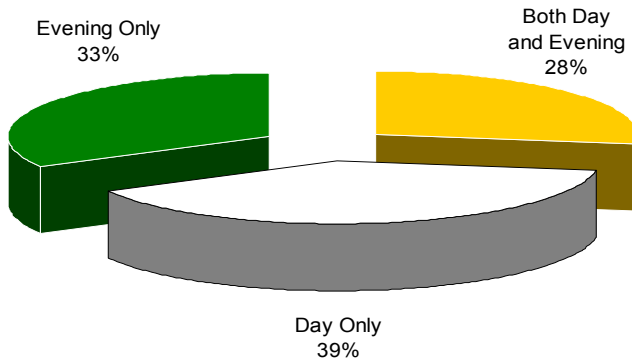
Total Degrees and Certificates Awarded 2000-2001 – 2004-2005



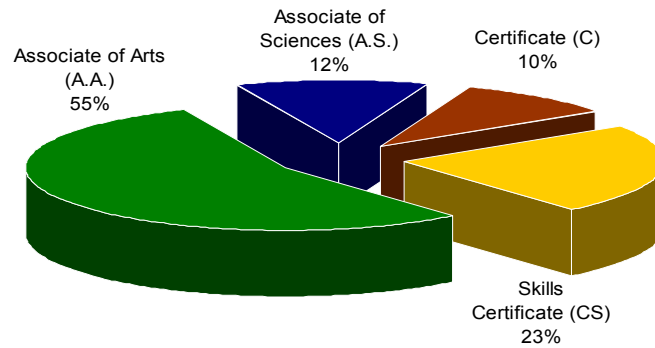
Degrees and Certificates (Awards) by Ethnicity 2004-2005



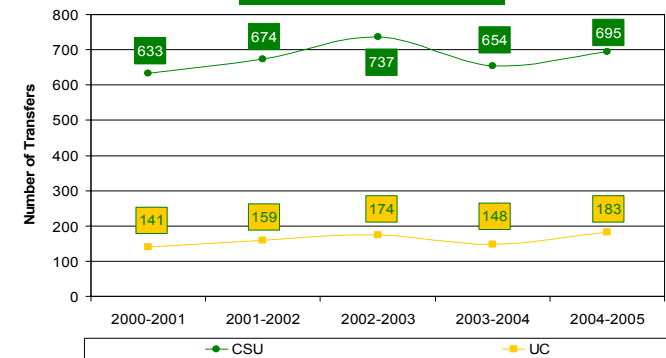
Time of Attendance



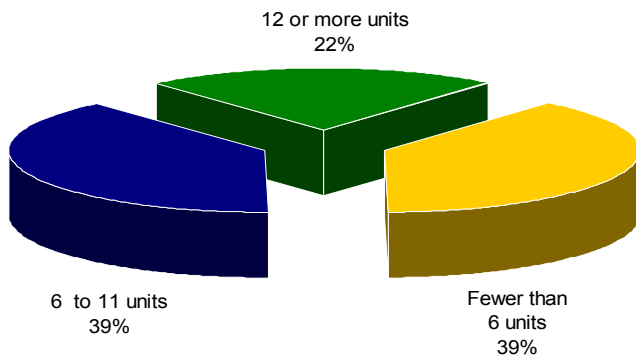
