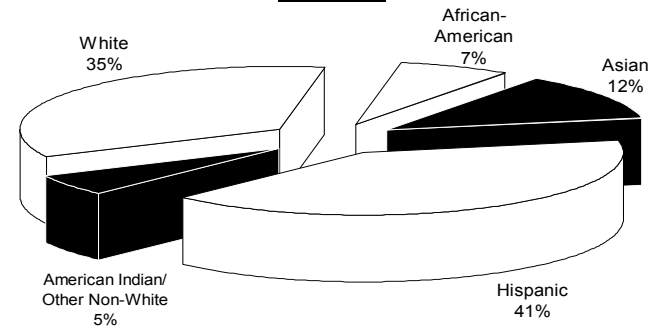
Credit Headcount Fall 2001 - Fall 2006

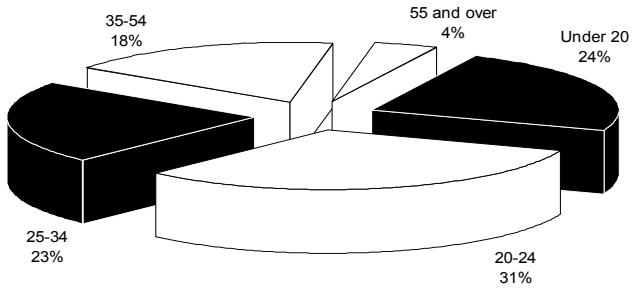

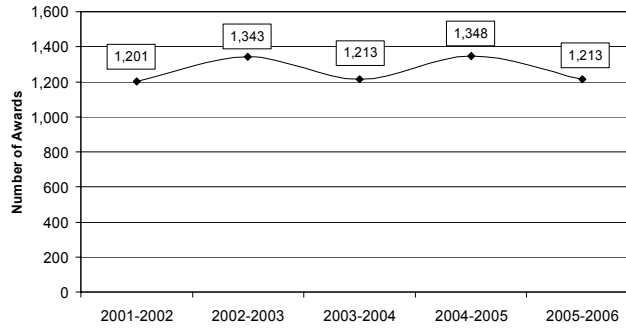

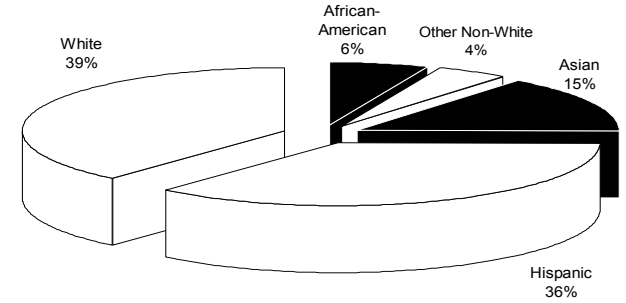

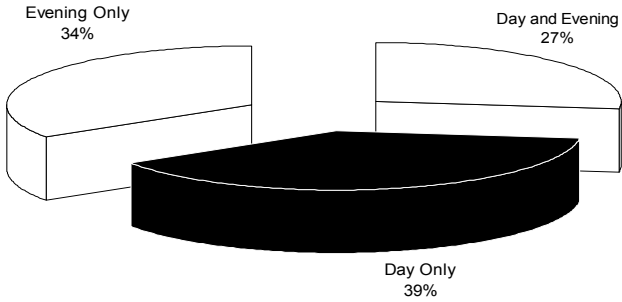
Total Degrees and Certificates Awarded 2001-2002 - 2005-2006



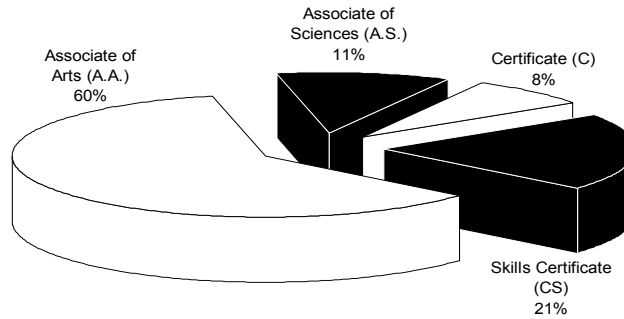
Degrees & Certificates (Awards) by Ethnicity 2005-2006



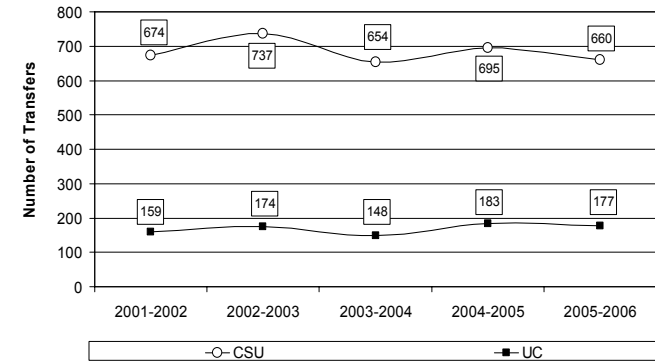
Time of Attendance



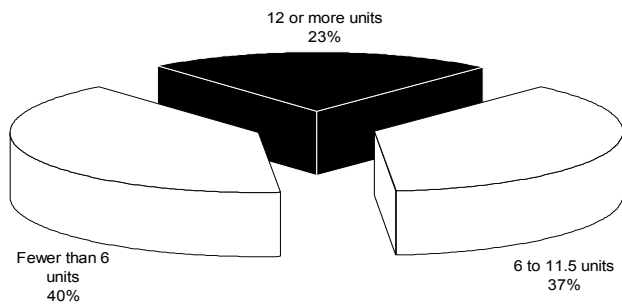
