Area Description: CalWORKs is an education and training program established for students receiving Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) to aid them in becoming economically self-sufficient. The program offers supportive services such as planning, childcare, books, tutoring, paid Work Study, job placement, and community referrals.
