The Los Angeles Valley College Foundation is the non-profit organization of LAVC; we are a 501(c)(3) IRS designated organization. Our mission is to provide support for campus programs and project, and more importantly to support students through scholarships and awards.

Provide an implementation plan/timeline:

1. PRO LAVC is marketed to the faculty and staff yearly, but focuses on faculty opening day in the fall. Accounts are established with the Foundation for a group’s project or program. Funds that are raised by each program are matched up to a certain amount by the Foundation. Funds are generally used for a variety of needs that ultimately benefit students directly or indirectly.
2. Scholarship Season begins in the Spring Semester. The Foundation office staff interact with students in a few ways. First, they provide information for students interested in applying for scholarships and encourage them to do so. Second, students who win scholarships are invited to attend Scholarship and Awards Night to meet the donors of their scholarships as well as to receive their awards.
3. The Alumni Association conducts two speaker series. The first is the “Spotlight Speaker” where we invite notable personalities to come speak about their profession. The second is “Welcome back my former student,” where a faculty member invites back two of his/her students who are now working in a particular profession such as the entertainment industry, plumbing, or geology. A series is scheduled at least once a quarter through out the year. Students are always invited to attend.
