Department Name: Upward Bound

Upward Bound is a federally funded program that assists non- traditional high school students in preparing for college. The student must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible for the program: the first to attend college in their family, financial and/or academic need.

The Upward Bound program provides after school tutoring, Saturday Academic Enrichment Academies, Parent Workshops, Mentorships, Internships, College Counseling and College Application Readiness, a six-week Summer Program, College Visits and Tours and Cultural Events all in an effort to prepare students for college.

Students will improve GPA in English and Math to the level of LAUSD's standard of proficient or better.	Students initial placement and assessment of transcripts and records upon entering the UB program will be used as a benchmark of their English and Math level. Collection and examination of 5 week progress reports and semester grades in English and Math will be used as second benchmark after applying individual goals and strategies.
