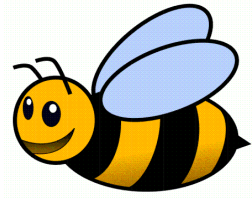


# Los Angeles Valley College Theater 2009-2010 Season

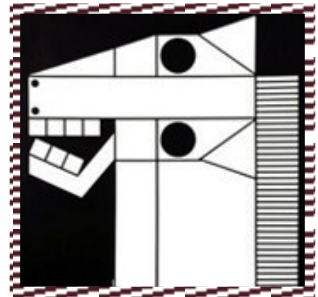


## AFTER 4-PLAY
