Students will be able to use verbal and written skills in discussing personal goals, strategies to secure and maintain employment, workplace relationships, conflict resolution, consumer awareness, legal rights, involvement in state and local government.	Students will demonstrate knowledge through role-play activities with teacher using scorecard to access high, medium, and low levels of competence in conversational settings.  Following objective State guidelines, CASAS pre and post tests determine achievement levels. Also, module tests are conducted using a rubric that generates pass/fail in conversational / writing skills.
Students will be able to form sentence and multiple paragraphs to form essays.	Students will formulate essays and be assessed for skill levels of syntactical structures, paragraphs, and essays using a standardized point system.
