1. Perform critical thinking functions such as comparing, contrasting, criticizing and assessing in order to understand, summarize, and analyze the main themes and ideas, vocabulary, and structure of advanced-level cultural and literary texts.
2. Engage in discussions surrounding the texts and assigned topics, and demonstrate high-advanced fluency and accuracy in the four language skills: reading, writing, listening and speaking.
3. Assimilate the new vocabulary and idiomatic expressions, and integrate them into written and oral communication.
4. Compose coherent essays in French, with special emphasis on stylistics, form, content, purpose and style. Demonstrate the ability to express thesis statements clearly, to create effective introductions and conclusions and well-structured development paragraphs with effective transitions.
5. Evaluate, revise, and proofread first drafts to correct mistakes and improve written expression (correctness and style).
6. Compose and present a well-structured French exposé on an assigned topic to be researched.
7. Distinguish, compare and contrast the different elements of the culture of France and the Francophone world, including basic history and art, and assess their contributions by studying the literature of 19th and 20th century French and Francophone authors.
