The student will be able to demonstrate how to recognize and respond to the physiological and emotional signs and symptoms of both life-threatening emergencies (i.e. cardiac respiratory distress) and non-life-threatening emergencies (i.e. abrasions, fractures, hypothermia, altitude sickness, etc).	Skill demonstrations and standardized written exams are required by the American Red Cross and the American Heart Association. Receipt of First Aid and Safety certification.
