Course Level Student Learning Outcome	Assessment Measure
Using vocabulary and structures appropriate to the student's level*, the student will be able to engage in a conversation in Italian.	Evidence of attainment of the SLO may include (but is not limited to) the oral <i>performance</i> of role plays, sketches, audio/video portfolios, presentations, oral interviews, etc., in the target language. These may be <i>presented</i> as a live <i>sketch</i> or <i>dramatized</i> in audio/video format and will include provisions for <i>self-assessment</i> and <i>revisions</i> . A linguistic rubric will be used to <i>assess</i> the students' output.

* A student may take Italian 8 at the Italian 2, 3, 4 or 5 competency level.
