The Committee discussed the proposed revisions to BR 6201. The changes involve incorporating the new SB 1440 requirement for general education into the language. The committee had no objections.

III. Discussion Items

a) Change to Prerequisites, Corequisite, and Advisories in Title 5

The Board of Governor's voted to approve change to Title 5 regarding Prerequisites, Corequisite, and Advisories. We need to begin looking at how we should modify our content review process to be more rigorous. It was suggested that we use the CB 21 rubrics for math and English to identify the exit skills so that faculty can determine the appropriate course as a prerequisite.
