Early today I emailed you about the campus being closed today and condemning the killing of George Floyd.

The Chancellor's Cabinet also met today to discuss securing campuses. Governor Newsom, the County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors, and Mayor Eric Garcetti have all declared new states of emergency for our region and, in response, we are further securing our college campuses. We are asking all staff to telecommute Monday through Wednesday of this week, June 1 – 3, 2020.

During this time, we will assess the security of our colleges daily and may call staff back sooner, or extend the full telecommute as needed. Essential employees may be asked to return to work during this time for emergency or other urgent duties. Any staff member that has not specifically been directed to work on site during this time may only come back to campus with my advance authorization. If this is the case, let me know and copy your supervisor, dean, and vice president.

Please be sure to check your email daily for updates. I'll do my best to send any update by 5pm.
