


FAQ's: Logging on to LAVC ARC Online Tutoring

Q: How do I access online tutoring?


- 1. ARC's tutoring service will be held online. To access tutoring, please go to https://web.penjiapp.com
- 2. On the Penji Social Learning webpage, click "Get Started" if this is your first-time signing in and you will be prompted to create an account. If you have already created an account, press "Already used Penji before? Sign back in."




3. After clicking "Get Started", you will be asked to fill in some information. Please fill in your student e-mail and agree to the terms of services and privacy policy.




4. After creating filling in your student e-mail, you will be asked to create a password.




5. After creating a password and hitting next, you will be asked to choose between "learn" and "teach", please press "learn" and then click "next".




6. You will now be asked to choose what LACCD college you are enrolled in. Please click on "Los Angeles Valley College".



7. You will now be taken to a page with the different tutoring centers. Click on the tutoring centers you wish to get tutoring for. (Ex. LAVC | The Math Lab)



- 8. You will now be prompted to create a profile. Please fill out your information on the profile and click "next"
- 9. An e-mail verification will be sent to your student e-mail to verify your account. Once you verify your e-mail and account, you can begin accessing ARC's tutoring services.





Q: How do I access the LAVC Online Writing Center?


1. After choosing the LAVC | Writing Center in the Penji homepage, you will enter into the LAVC Online Writing Center where you will see four buttons: 1) Writing Tutoring on Discord, 2) Drop off Paper, 3) Join a Workshop, 4) Writing tutoring on Zoom.




2. The LAVC Online Writing Center will be using Discord and Zoom for tutoring with Discord being the preferred platform. Most tutors will be available on Discord with only a couple tutors available on Zoom.

Writing Tutoring on Discord

If you do not already have the discord app, please go to https://discord.com/ and download the discord desktop app or go to the App store or Google Play Store and download the Discord mobile app. Once you have downloaded the app, click on "Writing tutoring on Discord".




- 2. This will take you to a webpage asking you to join the Writing Center Discord Server if you already have a discord account. If you need to create a discord account, please continue to step 3.
- 3. If you do not have a discord account, you can either open the Discord app or click "continue to Discord".






- 4. You can then register for a new Discord account. Click "register"
- 5. Type in your information and click continue.




6. You will be asked to verify your e-mail. Click "Verify Email" and go to the email you used to create the Discord account with.

Click Verify Email in the delivered email, and you're good to go!




7. After verifying your e-mail and logging into your Discord account, you will receive a message asking you to join the Writing Center Discord Server. Click "Join LAVC Writing Center." You will not have access to the LAVC Writing Center Discord Server. Please follow the instructions given to you by the admins of the server.




Writing Tutoring on Zoom


1. If you prefer to have a tutoring session on Zoom (note: there will be limited tutors on Zoom so please be prepared to wait), click on "Writing tutoring on Zoom".




2. You will then be prompted to pick a class. Please click "Join a class".




3. In the search box, type in the class you are wanting tutoring for (Ex. English 101) and then click the class as it appears.



4. Click on the class you want tutoring for to make sure it is highlighted in blue and click next.



- 5. On the following page, click "check in" under "Zoom Drop-In" during the hours that the LAVC Online Writing Center is opened.
- 6. Once you checked in, a tutor will contact you to begin your tutoring session.
