Grants Update

- CA College Pathways (EOPS) - \$25,000 – CSUN and the Pritzker Foundation LAVC partner not lead – AWARDED through Valley College Foundation Office
Multi-campus network to serve foster youth in north Los Angeles County partnership with CSUN, LA Pierce and LA Mission.
- Aspen Institute / ASCEND Fund (FRC) – Foundation Grant - \$50,000
Expand the reach of the FRC by creating a tool box to pilot FRC programs and services on other college campuses. Still pending.

AB86 California Career Pathways Grant

There are potentially two District submissions. LAVC is discussing participation in these consortiums.

1. STEM & Information technology (media arts) pathways (ELAC lead)
2. Advanced Manufacturing pathways
