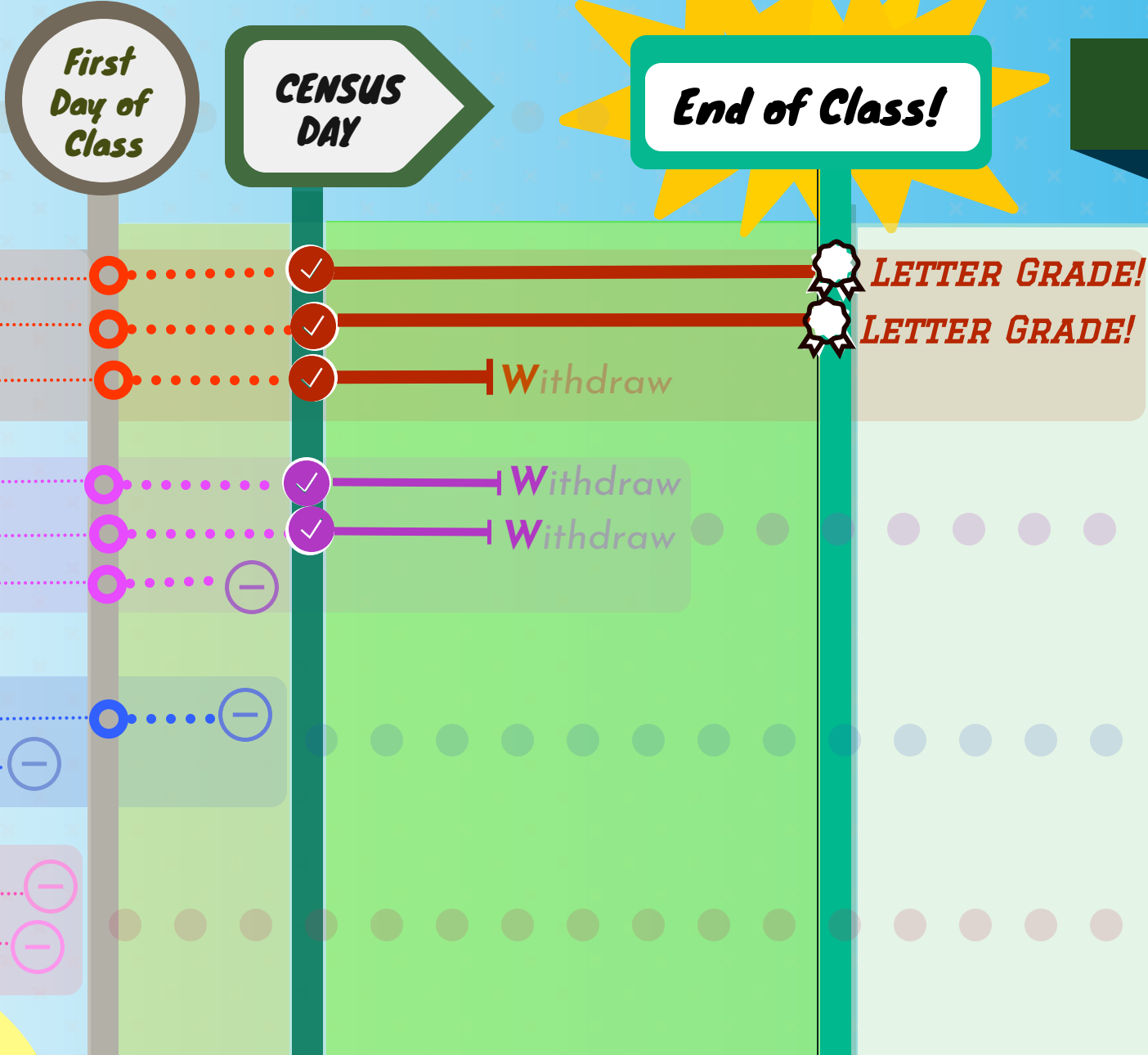


# HEADCOUNT vs. ENROLLMENT

*What's the difference?*

**HEADCOUNT:** count of each individual *STUDENT*  
**ENROLLMENT:** count of all the *COURSES* taken

Being counted in the official totals depends on whether the student is enrolled on the Census Day for that particular class.

**Each student enrolled beyond census is counted (once) in the headcount total.**

**Every class enrolled in at census is counted to get the total number of (course) enrollments.**

Being enrolled on the first day won't count in enrollment or headcount

Even students who withdraw or fail after census will be counted in the official HEADCOUNT total. All of their courses will be counted toward ENROLLMENT.

Number of individual students enrolled on or after census

Count of every class that was enrolled in at census
