

SUCCESSFUL COURSE COMPLETION RATES

Course Completion Rate tells us the percentage of grades C or better for a class or set of classes. It gives us a quick way of comparing how well students did whether for an individual class or the entire college

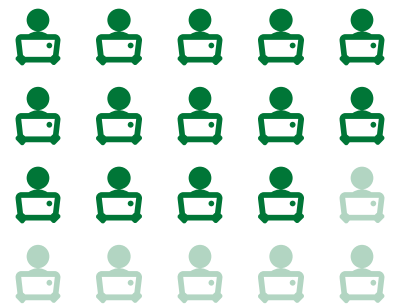
Calculating Successful Course Completion Rate

$$\text{divided by } \frac{\text{number of A, B, C (or P) Grades}}{\text{number of ENROLLMENTS}}$$

Example: A SINGLE CLASS

In a class of 20 students where 14 earn an A, B, or C, the successful course completion rate is

$$14 \div 20 = 70\%$$



Duplicated Enrollment

When looking at Successful Course Completion Rates for an entire Discipline or College, keep in mind that individual students often enroll in several courses and receive several grades. **Each enrollment and grade goes into the calculation.** Also note that withdrawals that earn a "W" are counted in the number of enrollments



Enrolls in 3 classes, earns: **B W C**



Enrolls in 5 classes, earns: **B C D A B**



Enrolls in 2 classes, earns: **A B**

10 enrollments
8 grades "C or above"

$$8 \div 10 = 80\%$$

successful course completion rate
