



LAVC Process for Coming On-Campus

LAVC is changing the way everybody will access to the college in response to the changing conditions of the pandemic.

Effective May 3, 2021, all faculty, staff, students and visitors must either use the LAVC SAFE App or the Covid-19 Symptom Self-Checker on the college website for every day that they access the college, and will no longer need to physically check-in with the College Sheriff.

Employee Process

The following is the process for an employee to come to campus:

- 1. Notify your supervisor when you are coming onto campus.**
 - Employees working on campus on a regular basis should communicate with their supervisor about his/her on-campus work schedule.
 - Employees who are not on campus regularly at pre-scheduled times should email their supervisor or dean to notify when he/she is coming to campus.
- 2. Read the latest [LACCD Safety Advisories](#).**
- 3. Before coming onto the campus each day, complete the LAVC health screening** using the LAVC Safe app (see last page for instructions) or the [online LACCD Covid-19 Symptom Self-check Questionnaire](#).
- 4. While on-campus, LACDPH and LACCD Safety Advisory must be adhered to at all times**, including:
 - Wear facial coverings
 - Maintain 6 feet of physical distance
 - Wash hands regularly
 - Wear face shield (if required)
 - Wear disposable gloves (if required)
 - Congregating among employees is not allowed.

Student Process

The following is the process for students taking in-person classes to come to campus:

- 1. Read the latest [LACCD Safety Advisories](#).**
- 2. Before coming onto the campus each day, complete the LAVC health screening** using the LAVC Safe app (see last page for instructions) or the [LAVC webpage](#).
 - Student athletes should continue to follow the check-in process set by the Athletics department and their coach
- 3. While on-campus, LACDPH and LACCD Safety Advisory must be adhered to at all times**, including:
 - Wear facial coverings
 - Maintain 6 feet of physical distance
 - Wash hands regularly




Step 1

Download the LAVC SAFE app on the Google Play App Store or the Apple App Store.




Step 2
