This program also provides students with the necessary preparation to transfer to the CSU system and complete a baccalaureate degree.

## Students with an AA-T or AS-T degree receive:

- · Admission priority
- Guaranteed admission with junior status to the CSU system
- Complete a baccalaureate degree with only 60 additional semester units (or 90 quarter units) (in a degree program that has been considered similar)
