### Assignment (80 points possible)

Research the position which is higher than yours.

What preparation does it take? (experience, school, degree, certificate)

Is there a physical requirement? (size, strength, special coordination)

What skills do you have to have? (physical skills, mental skills, verbal skills)

What personal traits must you have?

Conduct 3 interviews with people who are or have been in this position.

Read 4 articles or books on this position. (please include the name, author, date of these articles/books)

Include or attach a job description from a personnel office or type one yourself.

## **GRADING SCALE**

The paper is worth a total of 80 points. (45% of final grade). Employer rating/evaluation is worth up to 100 points. (55% of final grade). Total points possible is 180.
