






### Q3 Are you currently employed as a Registered Nurse?



## Q4 Work status:



### Q5 How long after graduation did it take you to find employment?





### Q9 Are you currently enrolled in a BSN program or other higher degree nursing program?



### Q10 If you are NOT currently enrolled in BSN program or other higher degree program, are you planning to enroll?



### Q11 Did you participate in the ADN to BSN collaborative program?





I had been hired to work at Providence Tarzana for their new grad program, and they said that new grad prpogram took precedence over all else. So when they continued to schedule me on Tuesdays to work, and I told them I couldn't, I ended up having to choose whether to finish out my schooling at U. of Phoenix, or quit and figure out how to finish it on-line. I ended up quitting Providence since I am so close to graduating - but a lot of people in the U. Of Phoenix class ended up quitting in order to get a job. I believe that after the initial training period at a hospital (at least 3-4 months) it will be easier to do a school program online. Also, for the Public Health Nursing classes that are part of the BSN, they require at least 90 hours of volunteer work.
