Look for the small blue comment boxes throughout your assignment. If you do not see any, then your professor did not leave these type of comments. If you see blue comment boxes, click on them to see your professor's comments.



6. Once you click on the small blue comment boxes, another window will open showing you the professor's comments. Press the X in the upper left corner to close this window after reading the comment. This will take you back to your assignment file where you can continue to click on the small blue comment boxes.



7. Your professor may also make corrections, which you will see in red on the assignment file.
