


Viewing Instructor Feedback on Canvas Mobile App

It is very important to view instructor feedback. They offer advice that will help you do well in the class. Your instructor may leave general comments and they might also leave specific comments within your submitted file. It is best to check for both. Below are instructions on how to access these comments on the Canvas app on a mobile device.

1. Click on grades

2. Click on the assignment you want to view

4. In the submission window, to view general comments, drag up on the tab at the bottom of the screen.



5. In order to view specific comments within your submitted file, click on where it says, “text submission” or “file submission.” Your submitted assignment will open. Look for the small blue comment boxes throughout your assignment. If you do not see any, then your professor did not leave these type of comments. If you see blue comment boxes, click on them to see your professor’s comments.



6. Once you click on the small blue comment boxes, another window will open showing you the professor's comments. Press the X in the upper left corner to close this window after reading the comment. This will take you back to your assignment file where you can continue to click on the small blue comment boxes.



7. Your professor may also make corrections, which you will see in red on the assignment file.
