



If you do not wish to participate in the survey please decline participation by clicking on the "disagree" button.



## Q2 How would you best describe yourself?



### Q3 Did you vote in the California Primary?









### Q7 Did you vote at the voting center at Los Angeles Valley College?















## Q15 Which day did you vote on?



## Q16 What time of the day did you vote



## Q17 Approximately how long did you wait in line to vote?







## Q20 Were you asked to show picture identification, such as a driver's license, at the polling place?



## Q21 Was this your first time voting at this particular polling place?





### Q23 Did you encounter any problems with the voting equipment or the ballot that may have interfered with your ability to cast your vote as intended?



## Q24 Did you need help or assistance voting due to a disability?





## Q26 Were you able to successfully vote?



## Q27 Were the poll workers able to address any questions or issues you encountered in the voting process?


