Reminder—Set Up Your New LACCD Password & Extra Login Authentication by October 21

The LA Community College District is requiring all students to update their password and use a Multifactor Authentication (MFA) to access their student email, the myCollege.laccd.edu Student Portal, and all Office365 applications; the deadline was extended to October 21, 2022. This means you will have to use a 14-character password as well as approve "sign-ins" using a second method after entering your password. Measure LA is a new \$5.3 billion bond measure on the ballot this fall that would allow for further investment in our campus. Specifically, this bond, if it passes, would allow us to invest in things like upgraded information technology, renovations to our gym, press box, and athletic fields, improved sustainability like energy efficient LED lighting, basic but important infrastructure needs, as well as allowing us to renovate older buildings like our Music, Art, and Motion Picture buildings, and our Planetarium, at a cost to homeowners of no more than 25 dollars per \$100,000 of assessed – not market – property value.
