ARTICLE 1: SHPE.

- A. Society of Hispanic Professional Engineers (SHPE)
- B. Purpose: Build a year-long project involving computation and robotics. (We will decide between AI-Nerf Gun, Taser Trap, or something else).
- C. No dues must exceed \$2 per semester. Any other assessment must be voted on by the entire club and be voluntary.
- D. Time, place, and frequency of meetings

Meetings will be every Friday at 2:00 pm in LARC 229.

Special or emergency meetings must be approved by the Club Advisor & the Club President.

All meetings held on and off campus must abide by college rules.

The last meeting of the semester will be held one week before the final examination schedule.

Article 2 - Membership.

A. Eligibility

- 1.) All members must pay their \$10 SHPE Fee.
- 2.) Everyone must either fall into either category:
- a.) You want to build something challenging.
- b.) You want to learn by building.

B. JUST COME AND BUILD. MAKE FRIENDS TOO.

Membership will not be limited based on age, race, religion, or national origin.

ARTICLE 3 - OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS.

A. PRESIDENT: RUN THE CLUB, PAPERWORK, FUNDING REQUESTS.

VICE-PRESIDENT: Assist the President and take over club meetings when the

President is absent, Paperwork with the President.

SECRETARY: Club logistics.

TREASURER: Manages all finances related to the club aka money.

ICC: Influence others on the teachings of MESA and its son, SHPE.

B. This is a new club. And we must spearhead the club as the go-to club at lavc.

So, we will make an election for only the role of president.

Then the president selects officers for the other positions himself.

C. Special elections:

If an officer leaves the club by voluntary choice, transfer, or voted out...

We will host an election to choose the next officer.

D. Term of office:

For SHPE, we will host one election year-round.

Changing officers per semester destroys the vision of SHPE.

Elections after September 16 occur if an officer leaves their position. See Article 3,

Section C.

E. Special requirements:

No requirements.

Just make sure your actions match your words.

ARTICLE 4 - CLUB RULES.

A. Club rules set up by the Los Angeles Community College Board of Trustees will be reviewed by the president and advisor with the membership at a meeting of each club early in each semester.

B. A club may be discontinued by lack of interest or disciplinary measures on the recommendation of the ASU Senate, with the approval of the Vice President of Student Affairs.

ARTICLE 5 - SHPE CONSTITUTION CHANGES.

A. Everyone will vote on the new change to the constitution. The officers will discuss the change. The president and club advisor will decide on the final verdict if approved.
