 - Students will study about themselves and others as members of a larger society

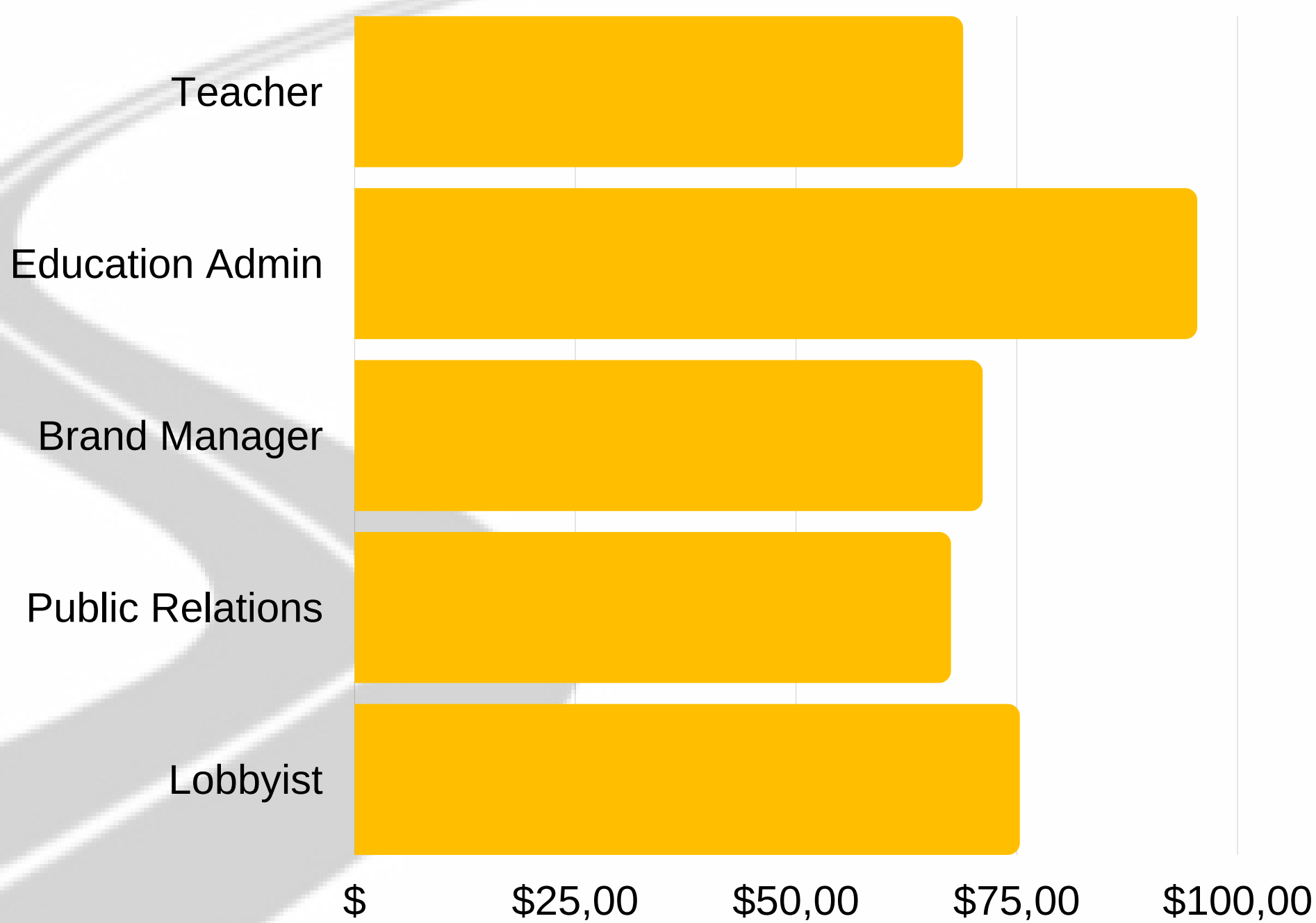
